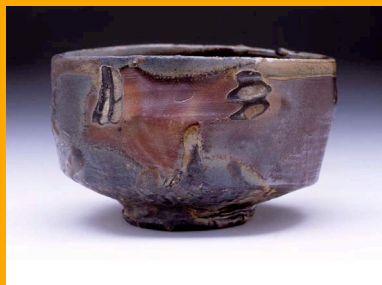

I have been making wood-fired work since 1991, working primarily with "anagama" style kilns and unglazed clay surfaces. Most of my work is made using a porcelain style clay that I developed especially for wood-firing. I enjoy the colour palette of earthy blushes through to dramatic glassy blacks achieved by the interaction between this clay and the wood-fire process.

I work with a range of construction techniques including wheel throwing
